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The motion of Plaintiffs/Petitioners in Kimble et al. v. Harris et al. (San Bernardino County Case No. CIVDS1012922) (Lead); Public Lands for the People, et al. v. California Department of Fish & Game, et al. (San Bernardino County Case No. 1203849); and The New 49er's, et al. v. State of California; California Department of Fish and Game, et al. (Siskiyou County Case No. 120048) for an injunction concerning suction dredge mining came before this Court on June 23, 2015.

The Court having reviewed the extensive pleadings filed by the parties, and having heard argument from counsel for all parties at the hearing on June 23, 2015,

THE COURT HEREBY FINDS:

- 1. The Department of Fish and Wildlife continues to refuse to issue permits to suction dredge miners notwithstanding this Court's January 12, 2015 ruling that such a refusal is not constitutional for reasons explained in that ruling. The Department has not developed regulations to replace those that this Court declared unconstitutional in the January 12, 2015 ruling.
- 2. The Department of Fish and Wildlife continues to enforce §§ 5653 & 5653.1 of the Fish and Game Code to prohibit suction dredge mining in California, including on federal lands where such action is not constitutional.
- 3. Such continued enforcement renders this Court's summary adjudication without force and effect, is causing continuing irreparable injury to Plaintiff/Petitioners, and is causing further judicial proceedings in the State through criminal proceedings initiated based on citations issued by the Department in which the Department in substance seeks to relitigate the question of federal preemption.
- 4. The issues of environmental impact raised by the Department and other parties from resumed suction dredge mining do not make out a case of concrete or specific public harm sufficient to withhold a grant of equitable relief, particularly when the relief is conditioned so as to maintain a longstanding regulatory scheme.

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THE COURT THEREFORE ORDERS:

- 1. The Department, its agents, servants, employees and attorneys, and all those in active concert or participation with it, are hereby enjoined and restrained from enforcing the provisions of the Fish and Wildlife Code prohibiting suction dredge mining in the rivers, streams, and waterways of California without a permit, and possessing a suction dredge near closed waterways in the limited circumstances where the suction dredge miner is:
 - (a) Operating on federal land; and
- (b) Is operating in compliance with the equipment requirements, restrictions in methods of operation, and use classifications and special regulations prevailing in 2009 when the Department ceased issuing permits (former 14 Cal. Code Regs. §§ 228(e) & (f) and § 228.5).
- 2. The Department, and its agents, servants, employees and attorneys, and all those in active concert or participation with it, are hereby commanded to develop and implement a program to issue suction dredging permits under regulations that do not stand as an obstacle to the accomplishment of the full purposes and objectives of federal mining law.
- 3. This injunction shall continue until this Court is presented with a noticed motion, in which the Department seeks relief from the injunction because it has developed a constitutionally-permissible permitting scheme and regulations.
